1. **Corporate/Company alumni groups** seem to fall into three major categories: independent groups pulled together by volunteers who create a Web site or a mailing list (like a Yahoo! Group), those actually sponsored by the former employer, and those which are developed on social network sites like LinkedIn.
2. **Military alumni groups** connect members of the U.S. Department of Defense services organizations. Members of the military, particularly those who trained, served in combat, and/or were deployed together, share a bond that is life-long, and many organizations support those networks, across the country.
3. **Government alumni groups** are a little sparse right now, but the corporate alumni groups list started at barely 25 a few years ago, so come back if you don't find your government department represented right now. If you know of an active alumni group which is not listed, let us know, and it will be added!
